

## **Apply for *Shine* – sector development e-Learning**

### **Agreement between MHCC ACT and participant organisations**

#### **Context**

MHCC ACT has purchased 10 places in the *Shine* Mental Health e-Learning course developed by the Western Australian Association for Mental Health (WAAMH). MHCC ACT is making this course available to our member organisations in order to evaluate the outcomes, with a view to making the course available more widely in future. We offer places during this trial at **\$40.00 each**, a discount of 67%.

#### **Description of training and time commitment**

The *Shine* Mental Health e-Learning course consists of eleven 20 minute self-paced modules, so it should take under four hours to complete them. They must all be completed within two months of initial registration. Students receive a 'Certificate of Completion'.

#### **The 11 modules cover:**

- Mental health carers
- Children of parents with a mental illness
- Mental Health within the community
- Community inclusion
- National standards for mental health services
- Applying lived experience in mental health peer work
- Person-centred approach in mental health
- Understanding recovery
- Working with Aboriginal people
- Youth mental health
- Alcohol and other drugs co-occurring issues

#### **Eligibility**

Applicants for this training must be MHCC ACT member organisations, and may be:

- Staff of our member organisations
- Volunteers of our member organisations

Organisations must apply for two individuals at a time to complete *Shine*.

#### **How to apply**

Note that completing the form does not finalise the agreement. There are only a limited number of places available. MHCC ACT will send a reply email with a countersigned agreement to confirm whether or not you have received a place.

**If your application for e-Learning is accepted:**

**MHCC ACT will:**

- Supply login details for each individual to complete e-Learning;
- Send the organisation an invoice for \$40 per individual.

**Participant Members will:**

Ensure that they understand the conditions under which this training is made available and ensure compliance with them. These conditions are that:

- Payment for the training has been made;
- All eleven modules are completed within one month of receiving login details;
- Following completion of the course, participants must forward a completed feedback form, including a short summary of their key learnings to MHCC ACT. This feedback will help us determine whether to make *Shine* available to more members in the future.
